Calculus Word Problems - **Calculus How To**

Answer $-6 < x < 2$ [Divide by 2.] In interval notation, the solution is the set $(-6, 2)$. Solve $3 < 4x - 1 < 5$. Answer $1 < x < 2$ [Divide by 4.] In interval notation, the solution is the set $(1, 2)$.
