Child development is the procedure of change and stability in children from conception through adolescences (Papalia, Olds & Feldman, 2008). Throughout history child development had not been considered important and little attention was paid to the many developments in cognitive talents, physical progress, and dialect use.

The rapid physical and cognitive development that marks adolescence creates a critical window of opportunity. The adolescent brain develops at a rate unseen since early childhood – making girls and boys hypersensitive to influences in their environments.

Child development that occurs from birth to adulthood was largely ignored throughout much of human history. Children were often viewed simply as small versions of adults and little attention was paid to the many advances in cognitive abilities, language usage, and physical growth that occur during childhood and adolescence.
