Denial is perhaps the most famous of the classical defense mechanisms, in part because it was an important concept as taught by Freud, but also because is has been emphasized by addiction recovery communities. In denial, a person simply refuses to accept that something which is true is in fact true.

### Defense Mechanisms - Mental Help

Devaluation and idealization are defense mechanisms that help a person manage their anxiety as well as internal or external stresses. While this subconscious protection system can be found in a few personality disorders, it is most often associated with borderline personality disorder (BPD).

### Devaluation and Idealization as Defense Mechanisms in BPD

Defense mechanisms operate at an unconscious level and help ward off unpleasant feelings (i.e., anxiety) or make good things feel better for the individual. Ego-defense mechanisms are natural and normal. When they get out of proportion (i.e., used with frequency), neuroses develop, such as anxiety states, phobias, obsessions, or hysteria.

### Defense Mechanisms | Simply Psychology

In contrast to other approaches, a dimensional model based on defense mechanisms is easily applied to personality disorders, eliminates the need for complex scales, retains the notion of entities with which clinicians are familiar, provide useful therapeutic strategies, and clearly specify what aspect of normal personality is overextended.
