United States v. Curtiss-Wright Export Corp., 299 U.S. 304 (1936), was a decision of the U.S. Supreme Court concerning the foreign affairs powers of the President of the United States . In its majority opinion, the Court held that the President, as the nation's "sole organ" in international relations, is innately vested with significant powers over foreign affairs, far exceeding the powers permitted in domestic matters or accorded to the U.S. Congress.
