If you are going to swaddle your baby it is important that you do so safely, so that you don't increase the chance of your baby having DDH: Make sure your baby's hips are drawn up towards the tummy and slightly open, like a book, 'frog' style. Your baby's knees should also be slightly bent. It may ...

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Screening for congenital dislocated hip (CDH) and developmental dysplasia of the hip (DDH) is part of the physical examination of newborn and 6-8 week old babies. Hip examination is a key element of the newborn examination. This screens for dislocated and dislocatable hips in relation to developmental dysplasia of the hips (DDH) which is a condition where the ball and socket joint of the hip does not form properly.

The Barlow and Ortolani tests are used to identify hip instability in infants until increased musculature limits their usefulness and sensitivity (around 3 months of age). Thereafter, an assessment of hip abduction should be performed. DDH can be bilateral, so symmetric abduction may be present although hip abduction will be limited.

The NHS Newborn and Infant Physical Examination (NIPE) programme screens newborn babies within 72 hours of birth, and then once again between 6 and 8 weeks of age, for conditions relating to their...

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This is either because signs suggestive of abnormality of the hip joint have been noticed or your baby has certain risk factors that can be associated with problems within the hip joint. The signs of hip abnormality include clicking or clunking of the joint, unequal leg length, asymmetric thigh creases or reduced hip movement.

Babies who have a positive clinical examination within 72 hours of birth should have an ultrasound by the age of two weeks (2 weeks+0), regardless of their risk factor status. Ideally the ultrasound should be done within 3 days with immediate harnessing if DDH (including dislocated and dislocatable hips) is confirmed.
