Dragon fruit can grow from seeds, but many people prefer a seedling so the cactus grows more quickly. Place some rocks in the bottom of a pot that's at least 2 feet deep and wide, followed by a 2-inch covering of sand for good drainage. It's important to choose a big enough container – in the wild, dragon fruit plants may grow 15 to 20 feet tall. You'll probably have to prune it to keep it from outgrowing the pot. A container that is at least 10 inches deep and 24 inches wide is the minimum size for a mature dragon fruit plant. This is the equivalent of a 10-gallon pot.

Dragon fruit grow easily from seed or cuttings. To grow from seed, squash some flesh onto paper towel and keep moist in a warm position but away from direct sunlight. Seeds will sprout 2-3 weeks later and can be potted up into punnets. Water weekly with eco-seaweed to develop strong seedlings and pot into individual pots once large enough.

Cut a store-bought or home-grown dragon fruit in half. Scoop the pulp out of the dragon fruit. The seeds are very small, so it's best to place the fruit pulp in a fine strainer. Use the tip of a finger to push the pulp around under running water to help dislodge the seeds.

To successfully grow dragon fruit, you will need to ensure that the plant only remains in temperatures between 32 and 90 degrees Fahrenheit. Dragon fruit is not capable of living in cool temperatures. Exposure to under 32 F (0 C) temperature is fatal. The temperature above 100 F (38 C) is also causing difficulties.
