When the United States wants to extradite someone who is residing in a foreign country with an extradition treaty, a complaint is filed in any U.S. court stating the charges and the treaty requirements.

International law concedes that the grant of and procedure as to extradition are most properly left to municipal law, and does not, for instance, preclude states from legislating so as to refuse the surrender by them of fugitives, if it appears that the request for extradition had been made in order to prosecute the fugitive on account of race, religion, or political opinions, or if the fugitive may be prejudiced thereby upon eventual trial by the courts of the requesting state.
