Syncope, commonly known as fainting, is one of the most frequent medical emergencies in the dental office. Syncope is the imbalance in the blood distribution of the brain and larger vessels within the body.

Syncope: The most common medical emergency in dentistry is syncope, 7,14 and the most accepted reason is because dental settings can be perceived as a stressful environment. The stressors can be physical and/or psychological. 7 Physical stressors can include discomfort from a procedure or pain due to an infection.

Special emphasis is placed on factors to be considered in risk-assessment, recognizing medical emergencies that are immediately life-threatening and must be acted upon promptly (e.g., cardiac arrest); and those problems that, while not immediately life-threatening, require timely stabilisation (e.g., hypoglycaemia).

Medical emergencies can therefore occur anywhere on the premises, not just in the surgery. It is essential that all dental health care workers should have the knowledge and skills to recognise and provide appropriate immediate medical care for emergencies that might present in dental practice.

Medical emergencies in Dental Practices are rare, however they do happen and all members of your dental team need to know their role in the event of an emergency. The General Dental Council emphasises that “ all dental professionals are responsible for putting patients interests first, and acting to protect them ”.

Vasovagal syncope was the most common medical emergency (15.97%), followed by moderate anaphylactic reaction (13.87%), seizures (8.81%), hyperventilation crisis (7.50%), and hypoglycemia (7.34%). The most common medical emergency in dental hygienists' practice in Poland is syncope followed by mild anaphylactic reaction.
