Mozart's Clarinet Concerto was the last major instrumental composition he composed; it was likely premiered in Prague on October 16, 1791, less than two months before his untimely death at age 35. Mozart composed it for the clarinet virtuoso Anton Stadler, a friend and a fellow Free Mason. Little more is known of their relationship, but surviving comments from Mozart's widow and sister-in-law have left a dubious portrait of Stadler.

Mozart's Clarinet Concerto is of supreme importance as his last instrumental work. Yet there are a number of special problems surrounding the piece, since the autograph is lost and the unique instrument for which it was written has not survived. This book provides evidence of the development of the clarinet, Mozart's encounter with it, and the composition and subsequent reception of the Clarinet Concerto.

Mozart - Clarinet Concerto in A, K622, completed in 1791, the year of Mozart's death, marked his farewell to instrumental music. It was also the first clarinet concerto to be written by a major composer – except that Mozart did not write it for the clarinet at all. In fact, it is rare that we ever hear this most famous of wind concertos played on the instrument Mozart intended – the basset clarinet, a clarinet that has four semitones added to its lower range.

The Clarinet Concerto is Mozart's last concerto, finished less than three months before his death in December 1791. For some it's pure unclouded joy, but others find shadows beneath the smiling surface. There's also the question 'what kind of clarinet?'

This is probably the most famous of all Mozart's concertos, and the only one he wrote for the clarinet. The piece is probably responsible for the clarinet still being so popular today, seeing as it was a fairly young instrument at the time with little repertoire. Most striking, though, is how mature it sounds.

This particular woks owes its existence to Mozart's friendship with the great clarinetist Anton Stadler, for whom he had earlier written the Quintet, K. 581. The concerto was originally sketched as a work in G Major for basset horn, a type of alto clarinet pitched five steps below the normal B-flat clarinet.
