It is important to note that the traits of narcissism among is already ingrained by the time they join the social media platforms as studies have proven. According to researcher Shawn Bergman, individual's personality is already established at the age of 7 years while the minimum age limit for joining Facebook is 13 years (Firestone, 2012).

Similar results can be found in a more detailed paper that examined how narcissism is generally manifested on social media - the researchers coded the Facebook pages of 156 students according to criteria such as photos, activity on the platform, number of lines in the About section. A group of independent "observers" was then asked to view each Facebook profile and answer questions on the content.

Several researchers have found a relationship between narcissism and frequency of using Facebook (Buffardi and Campbell, 2008, Mehdizadeh, 2010, Ong et al., 2011). If these findings are accurate, it suggests that when people are interacting with others on Facebook, they are more likely to be interacting with individuals who ...

While social media use can feed narcissistic traits by allowing self-promotion and attention-seeking, such a use can also decrease our empathy. We examined if empathy is predicted by trait narcissism in the context of attention-seeking motivation for selfie-posting. We studied both grandiose with vulnerable narcissistic traits as they differ in ...

This work examines the assumption that grandiose and vulnerable narcissism, although positively correlated, have different consequences for frequency and time expenditure of Facebook use and, additionally, the importance of social comparisons for both constructs. Participants completed measures of Facebook use, grandiose narcissism, vulnerable narcissism, social comparison orientation, and self-esteem.

Another approach is longitudinal, measuring narcissism and social media use over time and seeing if they are mutually reinforcing; that is, whether narcissism predicts increased social media use and whether that, in turn, predicts increasing narcissism. At least one study shows this pattern.
