Use a tongue depressor to allow movement of the oral cavity contents. Inspect the uvula and soft palate. Examine the buccal area and the gingivolabial (gingivobuccal) sulcus. Inspect lateral, superior, and inferior walls. Ask the patient to lift their tongue in the air.
