Research indicates that problem behaviors tend to fall into one of two categories: externalizing (aggressive, disruptive, or disobedient) or internalizing (anxious, depressed, or withdrawn).

Behavioral disturbances developed in 42 of the children (three of them brain damaged), forming a clinical sample whose temperamental characteristics as a group, in contrast to the nonclinical sample, included high or low activity, irregularity, withdrawal responses, nonadaptability, high intensity, persistence, and distractibility.
