Some claim that witchcraft dates back to pre-history. Others allege that what we generally consider witchcraft developed in pre-Christian Celtic times. Either way, the best known period in the history of witchcraft is the late Middle Ages and Early Modern period during which time hundreds of thousands of (alleged) witches were tried and tens of thousands burned by the Christian authorities in Europe's infamous witch trials.

In Homer's *Odyssey* (c.800 BC), Circe – who turns men into animals – is described as a witch, and Plutarch refers to witchcraft in his treatise *On Superstition* (c.AD 100). Illicit magic features heavily in Roman law statutes, some of which are passed down to the Christian world.

Witchcraft and the practice of it for either good (White Witches) or malevolent (to cause ill, death or to steal) was often viewed with a contradictory attitude in the middle-ages. The rise of the Protestant faith began to develop a more critical view of such beliefs and Martin Luther (1483 – 1546), a seminal figure in the Protestant Reformation, taught that witchcraft was a sin against the second commandment.

In the 16th and 17th centuries people across England, irrespective of status, believed in witches. Witchcraft was first made a capital offence in 1542 under a statute of Henry VIII but was repealed five years later.
