Light. Just like any other type of photography, your scene is always going to look the best in the flattering soft light of sunrise and sunset. Midday sun can create harsh shadows in your landscape, and make everything look dull. If possible, wait to capture your landscape until the sun is right near the horizon.

For standard landscape photography, there are two settings which we want to keep fixed: Aperture and ISO. Aim at keeping the ISO as low as possible and the aperture somewhere between *f*/7.1 and *f*/13.
