We call it a 'piggy-back' right. For example, if government policy means you cannot access your benefits because you are a family carer then you can challenge it based on your right to possessions, your benefits, and your right not to be discriminated against because you're a family carer.

In the UK, human rights are protected by the Human Rights Act 1998.The Act gives effect to the human rights set out in the European Convention on Human Rights. Article 3 - the right not to be tortured or treated in an inhuman or degrading way is one of the rights protected by the Human Rights Act.

Individuals have the right not to be subject to a decision when: it is based on automated processing; and, it produces an adverse legal effect or a significantly affects the individual. You must ensure that individuals are able to: obtain human intervention; express their point of view; and,

The Convention must be seen as a whole: all the rights are linked and no right is more important than another. The right to relax and play (Article 31) and the right to freedom of expression (Article 13) have equal importance as the right to be safe from violence (Article 19) and the right to education (Article 28).

The GDPR has provisions on: automated individual decision-making (making a decision solely by automated means without any human involvement); and profiling (automated processing of personal data to evaluate certain things about an individual). The right to be accompanied applies to any grievance hearing where an employee is complaining about a legal duty which their employers owes them, for example a contractual or a statutory right. The right does not apply where a worker asks for a pay rise, unless their contract provides a right to an annual increase.

The courts have decided that the right to life does not include a right to die. Separately, Protocol 13, Article 1 of the Human Rights Act makes the death penalty illegal in the UK. Are there any restrictions to this right? Article 2 is often referred to as an ' absolute right ' . These are rights that can never be interfered with by the state.
